

The Mayor and Council of the City of Franklin met in a Public Hearing on Tuesday, June 18, 2024, 5:45 p.m. at City Hall, 300 Iberia Street, Franklin, Louisiana. Mayor Eugene Foulcard called the meeting to order. Also present were Councilmembers Chuck Autin, Joseph Garrison, and Jaime Robison and City Clerk Karen LeBlanc. Absent were Councilmembers Larry Guilbeau and Lester Levine.
