The Mayor and Council of the City of Franklin met in Regular Session on Tuesday, February 18, 2025, at 6:00 PM at City Hall, 300 Iberia Street, Franklin, Louisiana. Mayor Eugene P. Mrs. Dianne Wiltz asked the council to support the resolution lifting the open alcohol container law for Dinner Under the Lamp Posts hosted by the Main Street Merchants. She also promoted the event.

MAYOR'S EXECUTIVE REPORT:

Mayor Foulcard read aloud his budget message for the amended and proposed budgets in lieu of his usual report.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS:

Mayor Foulcard stated that the December 2024 Financial Statements were presented to the council.

In Chief Cedric Handy's absence Lt. Gabriel Louis addressed the Mardi Gras parade. He stated that the parade is a family friendly event and stated that the Police Department will have a presence throughout the route. He reminded the public that it is illegal to conceal or carry a handgun at a parade. City codes related to disturbing the peace and holding unlawful assemblies were discussed. It was expressed that block parties will not be tolerated. Discussion held.
